

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

SIM-TEC 0.50 Potato Seed Treater is registered for use on Russet Burbank varieties only. Applied as a fungicide dust to potato seed pieces SIM-TEC 0.50 Potato Seed Treater helps to protect seed from invasion by *Fusarium Dry Rot* fungi present in the soil or on the seed surface and suppresses the development of *Rhizoctonia Stem Canker*. The use of high quality disease free seed, carefully selected and handled is the first consideration in obtaining full stands.

SIM-TEC 0.50 Potato Seed Treater will not control bacterial decay such as blackleg and soft rot, or have a curative effect on diseases already present within the seed.

SEED TREATMENT: Russet Burbank variety. SIM-TEC 0.50 Potato Seed Treater aids in the control of *Fusarium Dry Rot* seed decay and the suppression of *Rhizoctonia Stem Canker*. Use SIM-TEC 0.50 Potato Seed Treater at the rate of 1 lb. per 100 pounds of cut seed. Apply immediately following cutting with dispensing equipment which will apply a uniform deposit over the entire seed piece. Thoroughly clean and sanitize all cutting equipment such as cutting machines and knives, tables, equipment, planting equipment and planters before cutting and planting seed pieces. Treated seed should be planted immediately after cutting in warm, moist soil. Storage of cut seed can potentially increase the incidence of decay. Consult local University Agricultural Extension Agency for specific recommendations.



Tuber damage and/or decay may occur on sandy soils under moist soil conditions and higher than normal soil temperatures.
