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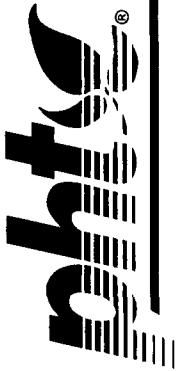

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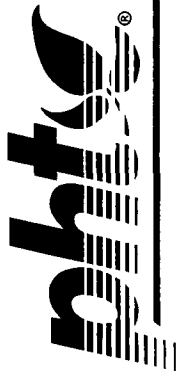

Prevent inhalation of dust by use of exhaust fans during treatment. Subject the seed potatoes to temperatures of 50 degrees to 55 degrees for 10 to 15 days before handling or cutting.

Before starting the cutting operation, thoroughly clean and sanitize all equipment which will contact the seed-pieces such as Cutting Equipment including, cutting machines, knives, tables and all other associated cutting equipment. Planting Equipment including, planters, truck beds and all other associated planting equipment. Plant treated seed immediately after cutting into soil sufficiently warm and moist to promote good wound healing. Storage of cut seed can potentially increase the incidence of decay. Consult local University or Agricultural Extension Agents for specific recommendations.

NOTICE P S T 6 will not control bacterial decay such as blackleg and soft rot, or diseases present within the seed.
