DIRECTIONS:

Begin in Early Spring and to each 1000 square feet, apply one ounce of FCC-20 with 3 gallons of water to treat area. Repeat every ten days during the entire turf disease season. After spraying, thoroughly clean the spraying equipment with water.

Empty containers should be crushed and buried. Spray wastes should be buried also where surface runoff will not be contaminated.

Keep children and animals off of treated areas until dry.
