It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner

To Operate: Shake can well before using. Turn dispenser upside down, point
 valve opening toward areas being treated. Press valve to release spray. This
 product is a liquid, non-selective persistent, general herbicide designed for
 use where control of all vegetation is desired. It is recommended for use on
 non-cropland areas, such as fence rows, parking lots, around buildings, load-
 ing ramps, storage yards, tank farms, industrial plant sites and other similar
 areas where grasses and weeds interfere with drainage, create a fire hazard or
 cause unsightly appearance. Apply in late spring after the most predominant
 weeds have emerged. Apply in such a spray pattern to wet out the weed com-
 pletely and the amount to use is dependent on the surface area of the weed to
 be controlled. The frequency of the application required depends on the soil
 type, rainfall and other natural conditions. Repeat as necessary.

Do not apply to areas underlaid by roots of desirable trees and shrubs. Do not
 use on lawns, walks, driveways, tennis courts, or similar areas. Do not use in
 or around the home. Do not apply when ground is frozen. Vapors from this
 product may injure susceptible plants in the immediate vicinity.
