Spray liberally into hiding and breeding places, contacting as many insects as possible. Repeat as necessary. For houseflies, mosquitoes, small flying moths (millers), and gnats: Close all doors and windows. Point nozzle upward, direct the spray mist to all parts of the room, especially windows and other light sources which attract these insects. Fill the room with mist then leave the treated areas. Keep the room closed for at least 15 minutes. Ventilate room when treatment is completed.
