DIRECTIONS FOR USE

For control of wasps and hornets: Apply after dark when all
of the insects have returned to the nest. Aim valve opening at
nest and depress button, soaking the nest with the spray.
Repeat as necessary. Avoid wetting vegetation with this
spray, as it will be damaged. Do not use as a space spray.

Other uses — Outdoors Only — For control of Ants, Clover
Mites, Crickets, Earwigs, Fleas, Millipedes, Sowbugs and
Brown Dog Ticks: Spray infested areas thoroughly including
outside surfaces of screen frames, doors, window frames,
foundations, patios or other places where insects may enter
or harbour. For ants, spray hills and runways. Repeat as
necessary. Do not spray vegetation. Do not use as a space
spray.

WARNING:

CONTENTS UNDER PRESSURE. Keep container away
from stoves, radiators, or other hot surfaces. Temperatures
exceeding 120°F may cause the container to burst. Do not
puncture or incinerate. See other precautions on back/side
panel.

May be harmful if swallowed, inhaled, or absorbed through
the skin. Avoid breathing of spray mist and provide adequate
ventilation of area being treated. Contact with skin, eyes, or
clothing should also be avoided. Wash thoroughly with soap
and warm water after handling. If poisoning occurs, get
prompt medical aid.

To physician — Atropine sulfate is antidotal.

Avoid contamination of food, utensils, food preparation
areas. Avoid contamination of fish ponds. Remove pets from
area before spraying.

Avoid excessive wetting of plastic, rubber and asphalt
surfaces of patios.
