1. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling.
  - a. Delete the Phenol Coefficient claims from your product.
  - b. Include the following headings above your left panel precautionary statements:

Precautionary Statements  
Hazard to Humans and Domestic Animals  
Keep Out Of Reach Of Children

- c. Delete the following ingredient(s) from your label ingredient statement. The ingredient(s) are no longer considered to be an active ingredient. Modify your ingredient statement percentages accordingly:

Sodium Metasilicate

Tetrasodium ethylene diamine tetraacetate



- d. Change the heading "First Aid" to read "Statement of Practical Treatment."
  - e. In the precautionary section, add the word "Corrosive" after the statement "Keep Out of Reach of Children" (left panel).
  - f. The "Directions For Use" heading and its misuse statement should be added with the Directions For Use instructions.
  - g. The signal word "Danger" should be placed directly below the statement "KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN" (center panel only).
  - h. Delete the word sanitizing in the disinfection section.
  - i. Revise the referral statement to read "See side panel for additional precautionary statements."
2. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with section 6(c) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act. Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.
