Mix Well Before Using

SPACE SPRAY-INDOORS: (For houseflies, mosquitoes, and gnats.) Fill spray tank with undiluted insecticide spray formulation. Adjust pressure and nozzle to deliver a fine mist spray. Close all doors and windows. Point nozzle upward, direct the spray mist to all parts of the room, especially windows and other light sources which attract these insects. Keep the spray nozzle at least four feet from fabrics at all times to avoid wetting or staining. Fill the room with mist at the dosage rate of one fluid ounce per 1,000 cu. ft. of space. Leave the treated room when treatment is completed and before re-entry.

INDOORS: (For roaches, earwigs, grain mites, scorpions, spiders and centipedes.) Fill spray tank with undiluted insecticide spray formulation. Keep spray nozzle about 8 to 12 inches from surface to be treated. Adjust pressure and nozzle to deliver a coarse spray. Spray thoroughly into cracks, crevices, moist areas, openings around pipes, baseboards, and storage areas. Apply spray until area is moist, but avoid run-off. Spray directly on insects where possible. Repeat as necessary.

ANTS: Spray trails, nests and points of entry. Spray on ants where possible. Repeat as necessary.

PLEAS: Hold spray nozzle about 18 inches from area to be treated. Apply spray at the rate of two seconds per linear foot. Direct spray on animal bedding, resting areas, and floor around these areas. Repeat as necessary. Treat animals with a registered flea control product before they re-enter the area.

WASPS: Apply in late evening when insects are at rest. Spray liberally into hiding and breeding places, contacting as many insects as possible. Repeat as necessary.
