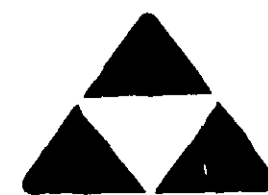
DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Horse and Pony Spray has been specifically formulated for use on your horse and pony show stock. Do not use on meat animals. This product may be sprayed onto the animal's coat and will protect from biting flies.

Apply spray at the rate of two ounces per animal. Do not spray around animal's eyes, ears, nose, or mouth. To treat these areas, apply spray liberally to clean cloth and wipe the head areas. Do not wet the animal's skin. After application, brush the coat to give overall coverage. Make sure the legs and ankles are treated. During fly-time, best protection will be given by treating animals 3 to 4 times each week.

CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed. Keep out of reach of children. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not contaminate feed or feeding utensils. Cover or remove feed before spraying. Keep out of any body of water. Do not use on meat or dairy animals. This product is toxic to fish. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment, or disposal of wastes.
