As indicated, referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable, provided that, for the label changes under the "Environmental Hazard" Section of the label, replace the statement "Do not apply directly to water or wetland" with the statement "Do not apply directly to water, to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark." This statement should be used on labeling of all products being registered for the first time, on amendments to labeling of existing products and to products being reregistered. Please submit five (5) copies of your final printed labels incorporating this amendment. A stamped copy is enclosed for your records.
