DIRECTIONS SHAKE BEFORE USE KEEP UPRIGHT WHILE SPRAYING

To Kill Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats, Wasps, Hornets, Sandflies, Small Flying Moths

Close all doors and windows and direct spray upward into center of room with a slow, sweeping motion. Spray 5 to 10 seconds for average room (1,000 cubic feet). Keep nozzle three feet from surfaces. Vacate premises. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate room thoroughly before re-entry. Sweep up and destroy the fallen insects and repeat treatment as necessary.

To Kill Wasps and Hornets

Application should be made in late evening when insects are at rest. Spray into hiding and breeding places contacting as many insects as possible.

To Kill Roaches, Waterbugs, Silverfish, Ants, Scorpions, Centipedes, Sowbugs, Spiders, Fleas

Spray baseboards, cracks, crevices, moist areas and openings around sinks and pipes and other hiding places, killing the insects directly. Spray ant hills and mud trails around windows and door frames, and other locations. For fleas, thoroughly spray animal quarters and sleeping areas. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Clothes Moths

Spray articles to be protected, paying particular attention to folds and seams. Spray interior of storage containers such as closets, chests, and trunks regularly. Treatment should be repeated every 3 to 4 days if the articles are stored for a long period.

To Kill Bedbugs

Spray mattress, sheets, pillows, curtains, and seams, and staff. Spray bedstead, baseboards, and floor cracks. Repeat regularly.
