DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

For use in rooms, apartments, attic, basements, campers, boats, garages, pet sleeping areas, storage areas, cabins and household storage areas. For houseflies, mosquitoes, rice weevils, black carpet beetles, small flying moths, spiders, saw-toothed grain beetles, wasps, pill bugs, crickets, fleas and silverfish. Aids in the control of cockroaches.

Cover exposed foods, dishes and food handling equipment. Open cabinets and doors to area to be treated. Shut off fans and air conditioners. Put out all flames and pilot lights. Close doors and windows. Use one unit for each 4,000 cu. ft. of unobstructed area. Do not remain in the area during treatment. Ventilate thoroughly before re-entry.

For Automatic Discharge: Remove cap. Point valve opening away from face and eyes. Invert up and lock on valve by pulling cap straight down over valve stem. Then place fogger on stand or table in center of room with valve locked open. Leave room at once and keep room closed for 4 hours before airing out. Open all doors and windows and allow to air for 30 minutes. Repeat spraying in 2 weeks or when necessary.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Do not store in extreme heat or cold. Store in a dry location in an upright position away from ignition sources. Store away from other pesticides, fertilizers, food, feed and water.

Disposal: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility. Consult local, state, or federal disposal authorities for approved alternative procedures.

Container Disposal: Replace cap and discard empty containers in trash, unless prohibited by local ordinances. Do not incinerate or puncture.
