



DIRECTIONS FOR USE
(General Classification)

SANITIZATION: (200 ppm product)
1 oz. (1 oz. product diluted in 4 gallons of water) to sanitize previously cleaned and rinsed non-porous food contact surfaces. Multiple items (glassware, utensils, china) immerse for at least 60 seconds making sure to immerse completely. Let air dry. Prepare fresh solution daily or more frequently as soil is apparent.

Use on counters, chopping boards, food tanks and food dispensing equipment in the wash area with 200 ppm solution for at least 60 seconds making sure to immerse completely. Let air dry. Prepare fresh solution daily or more frequently as soil is apparent.

DISINFECTION-Dilution Rates: For disinfection, the following steps are required and must be followed. Prepare a fresh solution for each use.

1. Add 2 level 5 gallon buckets of water to each 15 gallon bucket. This is effective disinfection against the organisms, *Salmonella choleraesuis* and *Staphylococcus aureus*. At 200 ppm for 60 seconds in this solution, it is effective as a disinfectant against *Escherichia coli*, *Staphylococcus aureus*, *Salmonella choleraesuis*, and *Pseudomonas aeruginosa*.

This product includes sanitizing and disinfecting in Restaurants, Bars, Food Processing Plants, Dairies, Hospitals and other institutions. When used as recommended it is effective as a sanitizer against *Escherichia coli* and *Staphylococcus aureus*, and as a disinfectant against *Staphylococcus aureus*, *Salmonella choleraesuis* and *Pseudomonas aeruginosa*. This product authorized under the Food Additive Amendment of the Federal Food, Drug and Cosmetic Act for use as a sanitizing solution at 200ppm (1 oz. of product diluted in 4 gallons of water) at this level NO POTABLE WATER RINSE is required.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

Your Application Dated December 3, 1982

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA is acceptable, provided that you:

1. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:
 - a. Add the sentence "It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling" immediately below the heading "Directions for Use" (General Classification).
 - b. Replace your "General Disinfection," paragraph b, 1st page, with a rephrasing of your paragraphs 3 and 4, below:

General Disinfection, to disinfect previously cleaned hard inanimate surfaces (such as walls, floors, table tops) use a use dilution by adding 3 oz. of this product to 1 gallon of water, and scrub with mop, cloth, sponge, or mechanical sprayer so as to get surface thoroughly. Allow to remain wet for 10 minutes and then let air dry. As a 1:1000 per 1 gallon dilution, this product has effective disinfecting activity against the organisms *Salmonella choleraesuis*, and *Staphylococcus aureus*.


2. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 1(s). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
