

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DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

(General Classification)

SANITIZATION-Use 200 ppm product solution (1 oz. product diluted in 4 gallons of water) to sanitize previously cleaned and rinsed non-porous food contact surfaces.

Mobile items (glassware, utensils, china) immerse for at least 60 seconds making sure to immerse completely. Let air dry. Prepare fresh solution daily or more frequently as soil is apparent.

Immobile items (countertops, chopping blocks, holding tanks and food dispensing equipment) flood or flush area with 200 ppm product solution for at least 60 seconds making sure to wet all surfaces completely. Let air dry. Prepare fresh solution daily or more frequently as soil is apparent.
