Uniformly spray one gallon of DILUTE VEGETATION KILLER mixed in ten gallons of water over 1,000 sq. ft. Thoroughly wet all foliage to insure contact. If results are obtained when applications are made, wait until weed emergence while growth is succulent. If weeds are tall and dense, use 1 1/2 gallons of DILUTE VEGETATION KILLER in ten gallons of water per 1,000 sq. ft. of hard-to-kill perennial weeds and grasses such as grass, bindweed, and wild carrot, use 3-4 1/2 sq. ft. Although DILUTE VEGETATION KILLER is active through foliar contact, much more effective through the roots and, therefore, adequate watering of the root zone is necessary. In areas where the rainfall is high and the ground is dry, a second application may be necessary to reach the soil surface. Care must be taken to keep the herbicide from desirable flower beds, lawns and shrub over roots of valuable trees or woody ornamentals. Apply herbicide outside the dripline of trees to desirable plants.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Uniformly spray one gallon of DILUTE VEGETATION KILLER mixed in ten gallons of water over 1,000 sq. ft. of soil surface. Thoroughly wet all foliage to insure contact action. Best results are obtained when applications are made during or after weed emergence while growth is succulent. Where vegetation is tall and dense, use 1 1/2 gallons of DILUTE VEGETATION KILLER in ten gallons of water per 1,000 sq. ft. For control of hard-to-kill perennial weeds and grasses such as johnson-grass, bindweed, and wild carrot, use 3-4 1/2 gallons per 1,000 sq. ft. Although DILUTE VEGETATION KILLER has considerable activity through foliar contact, much of its activity is through the roots and, therefore, adequate rainfall to move the chemical into the root zone is necessary. Under conditions where the rainfall is high and the growing season long, a second application may be necessary to maintain a weed-free soil surface. Care must be taken to keep this herbicide away from desirable flower beds, lawns and shrubs. Do not apply over roots of valuable trees or woody ornamental plants. Only apply herbicide outside the dripline of trees. Avoid spray drift to desirable plants.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Prohibitions: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited.

Pesticide Disposal: Pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate that cannot be used or chemically processed should be disposed of in a landfill approved for pesticides or buried in a safe place away from water supplies.

Container Disposal: (a) Reuse container and offer for reconditioning, or (b) Triple rinse (or equivalent) and offer for recycling, reconditioning, or disposal in approved landfill, or bury in a safe place.
