Your Letter Dated December 23, 1985

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

1. Front label: the Child Hazard warning should precede the signal word "CAUTION."
2. Delete the word "servicepersons," and in its place put "certified pest control operators." The statement should read "Only for sale to, use and storage by certified pest control operators." Alternatively, you may use the statement "Recommended for Commercial/Industrial Use."

Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

**Pesticide Disposal:** Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility. Open dumping is prohibited.

**Container Disposal:** Triple-rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities.
