DIRECTIONS

For Odor Control: Spray surface until moist. Repeat application on polished wood furniture or rayon fabrics. Repeat application periodically to maintain control.

GENERAL USES

Disinfecting: Air filters and ventilating duct louvers • bed frames • bedside and office furniture • chart racks and cabinets • countertops • door knobs • office machines and mirrors • light fixtures and switches • supply, trash carts • telephones • waste cans and laundry wheel chairs and walkers • urinals. Deodorizing: Odors from post-colostomy, post-ileostomy and bags, malignant diseases, homes, kitchens, bathroom plant processes, food processing and packaging plants, fecal matter, urine, burns, smoke, mildew and mold, onions, food putrefaction, perspiration, stale air, tobacco, musty closets and fish.
