DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with directions.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE. HOLD CONTAINER UP

TO KILL FLIES, GNATS, MOSQUITOES AND SMALL FLYING INSECTS: Spray area infested with these flying insects from shrubs, bushes and grassy areas. Spray windows and direct spray upward into center of motion. Spray 5-10 seconds for average room. Repeat after spraying. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects. Exposed food and utensils.

TO KILL CARPET BEETLES: Spray area infested with these flying insects from shrubs, bushes and grassy areas. Spray windows and direct spray upward into center of motion. Spray 5-10 seconds for average room. Repeat after spraying. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects. Exposed food and utensils.

TO KILL ANTS, CENTIPEDES, COCKROACHES, CRICKETS, SPIDERS: Contact as many insects as possible with thorough spraying of all parts of the room susceptible to pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators, food areas, and areas suspected of hiding. To kill ants, termites, ant trails and other areas of entry. Repeat as necessary.

TO KILL EXPOSED FORMS OF CONFUSED FLOUR BEETLE, SAN-TOOTHED GRAIN BEETLES: Find and destroy insects in all other items from pantry. Spray the shelves where insects present. Place clean paper on the shelves where insects have dried. Repeat as necessary.

TO KILL FLEAS AND TICKS IN PET BEDDING AND PET'S OLD BEDDING: To reduce infestation, thoroughly clean bedding, sleeping quarters, around baseboards, cracks, local areas of floors, and other resting places. Treat these areas at the rate of 1 to 3 seconds per square foot. Also spray pet's houses. Repeat as necessary. Put fresh bedding in pet's house. DO NOT SPRAY ANIMALS. Also treat dog and flea and tick control product before allowing

TO TREAT FLEA AND TICK INFESTATION IN RUGS AND CARPETS: Where fleas tend to hide. If used on 1/2" fabrics, test for potential staining in an inconspicuous place. Spray thoroughly into hiding places such as cracks, along baseboards, window and door frames. Repeat as necessary. Do not spray more than one square foot per second. Repeat as necessary.

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GENERAL: When sprayed directly on insects, this product kills (Eastern Tent Caterpillar, Aphid, Canine Spider Mites, Japanese Beetles, Mealybug, Ants, etc.) on Ornamental Cherry, Spirea, Roses, Crabapple, Andromeda, Azalea, Crysanthemum, Gardenia, Oleander, and Arborvitae. Caution should be used on young plants. WHEN SPRAYING, HOLD CONTAINER at arm's length. Spray in the evening or on a cloudy day. Spray rows at a rate of 1 foot per second. Repeat as needed. Do not spray more than one square foot per second. Repeat as necessary.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool dry area. Do not store in open flame.

DISPOSAL: Replace cap and discard container. Do not incinerate or puncture.
