The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all of the information submitted with your application to support the reregistration of the above referenced product in connection with the pyrethrin and pbo RED(s), and has concluded that your submission is acceptable.

NOTE: This product is not being reregistered under sections 3(c)5 and 4(g) of FIFRA at this time.

Please be reminded that 40 CFR Part 156.140(a)(4) requires that a batch code, lot number, or other code identifying the batch of the pesticide distributed and sold be placed on non-refillable containers. The code may appear either on the label or durably marked on the container itself, and can be added by non-notification per PRN 98-10.

Please note that the record for this product currently contains the Confidential Statements of Formulation (CSFs) listed below. Any previously dated CSFs are superseded.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. SHAKE BEFORE USING AND AT INTERVALS DURING PROLONGED USE. Hold container upright with nozzle away from you. Press valve down and spray as directed. To avoid possible staining of fabrics or surfaces, do not spray at close range. (Flies.) (Mosquitoes.) (Gnats.) (Midges.) (Wasps.) (Hornets) and (Flying Moths/Millers): Close all doors and windows and spray room at a rate of 1 second per 1000 cubic feet. Direct spray to all parts of room, especially windows and other light sources which attract these insects. Keep nozzle in constant motion. Keep room closed for 10 to 15 minutes after treatment. Repeat treatment as necessary. Restrictions: Do not apply this product in a way that will contact workers or other persons, either directly or through drift. Only protected handlers may be in the area during application. For space spray use: Do not remain in treated area. Exit area immediately and remain outside the treated area until aerosols, vapors, and/or mists have dispersed. Do not enter or allow others to enter until vapors, mists, and aerosols have dispersed, and the treated area has been thoroughly ventilated. For indoor applications: Remove or cover exposed food and drinking water before application. Remove or cover dishes, utensils, food processing equipment, and food preparation surfaces, or wash them before use. Do not use in aircraft cabins. For use in dairy barns or facilities: Close milk bulk lids to prevent contamination from spray and from dead or falling insects. Remove or cover milking utensils before application. Wash teats of animals before milking. For use in in food handling and processing facilities: Do not make space spray applications when facility is in operation. Prior to space spray applications, cover or remove food. Prior to space spray applications, cover food processing surfaces or clean after treatment and before use. 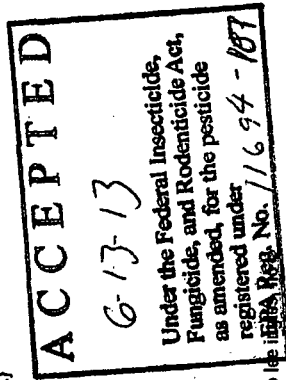
