(FLEAS & TICKS (ADULT AND LARVAE): Remove and thoroughly clean or destroy pet bedding. Spray pet steeping quarters, bed, entire floor and floor covering, with special attention to cracks and crevices around baseboards, and window and door frames. Infested upholstered furniture and mattresses may also be treated with this product. A test application should be made to upholstery or drapery fabrics in an inconspicuous place before use.)
