Enclosed please find all the documents and paperwork necessary for a CSF update and minor label change to our current registration of EPA #11694-110, The End.

The CSF update pertains to a minor typographical error in box 13b, % by weight. The component is Sodium Benzoate (CAS#532-32-1), and it should be 0.10, instead of 0.01.

The minor label change regards deleting a graphic depicting a spray pattern from the label.

I have included:



It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. 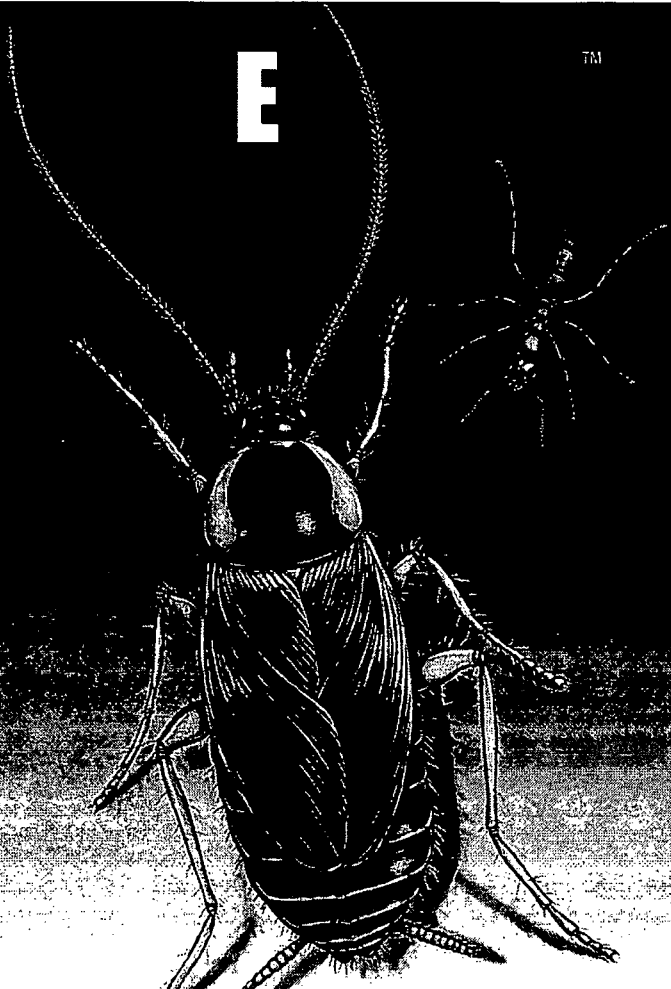
