General Purpose Disinfectant-Deodorizer

To disinfect walls, floors, and other hard surfaces that will not contact food products in homes, schools, rest rooms, and other public places: mop or sponge surface to be treated with a solution containing one (1) ounce of FRESH'N'FREE in each one (1) gallon of water. Surfaces that are soiled must be thoroughly cleaned and rinsed free of soil before disinfection. This disinfectant solution will effectively destroy the gram positive micro-organism *Staphylococcus aureus* and the gram negative micro-organism, *Salmonelli Choleraesuis*.

DANGER:

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

Corrosive. Causes eye damage and skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.

FIRST AID

If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately.

Note to physician: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.

Container disposal: Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard it.
