

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Al Chem 106 is used to control bacteria, algae, and fungi in recirculating commercial and industrial cooling systems. Upon its use, systems must be cleaned to remove slimes, and other deposits. An initial slug addition of Al Chem 106 fluid ounces of Al Chem 106 per 1000 gallons of water to provide a concentration of 8 parts per million, b

in the system, is recommended. Repeat initial slug additions of 0.2 Al Chem 106 per 1000

20 parts per million of Al Chem 106 should be employed every 2 to 5 days, or as needed. The frequency of addition depends upon the relative amount of bleedoff and the severity of the problem. Slug additions should be made in the summer months. Al Chem 106 is used for

air-washing systems that maintain effective concentrations of 3.33 Al Chem 106 parts per million.

Recommended. Repeat initial dosage until control is achieved. Initial dosages of 2.25 to 5.55 fluid ounces of Al Chem 106 per 1000 gallons of water should be employed. The frequency of addition depends upon the relative amount of bleedoff and the severity of the bacterial problem. Slug additions may be made in the summer months. collection trays of the airwash system.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Do not stack more than four drums high. Leaking drums should be disposed of. Spills should be absorbed in sawdust or similar material and disposed of in a sanitary landfill when not in use.
