Submissions dated May 22 and June 5, 1992, respectively

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. One copy of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment.

1) Revise your Environmental Hazards statement to read:

"This pesticide is highly toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to water. Drift and runoff from treated sites may be hazardous to fish in adjacent waters."

2) Revise the sentences, "All food processing surfaces should be covered. . . before using" and "Food contact surfaces. . with a potable water rinse after treatment", to read:

"All food processing surfaces and equipment should be washed with an effective cleaning compound followed by a potable water rinse."

For Reg. No. 11715-46, you must submit an updated Confidential Statement of Formula (EPA Form 8570-4 rev. '85).
