Dear Mr. Washburn:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments below:

- 1. In the FIRST AID box:
  - a. Revise "IF SWALLOWED" to read:

IF SWALLOWED: Immediately call a poison control center or doctor. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give any liquid to the person

However, if you have data to show there is a benefit in drinking water or milk, after ingesting your product, you may submit an alternate wording via amendment.

- b Add the statement "NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:" Contains petroleum distillatevomiting my cause aspiration pneumonia."
- 2. In the STORAGE AND DISPOSAL box, include the statement "Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal under the heading.

You must submit two (2) final printed labels before you release the product for shipment. A stamped copy is enclosed for your records.

#### PHYSICAL HAZARDS

#### **DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Restaurants, Homes, Food Packaging and Food Processing Plants: For control of flies, mosquitoes, gnats and small flying moths, fill the room with spray mist. Direct spray toward all parts of room and especially windows or light source which attracts these insects. Do not remain

in treated areas, ventilate the area after treatment is completed. Repeat as necessary.

Dairy Farms, Stables, Hog Houses: For the control of flies, gnats, and mosquitoes apply at the rate of seven seconds for each 1,000 cubic feet. Best time to apply is when stock is not in barn. Repeat as necessary.

Directions: If possible close space to be treated. Release three feet from any surface, holding the dispenser above the head. Moving the dispenser about while spraying aids in dispersion. Dispense only for time indicated. USE SPARINGLY. Seven seconds of spraying is ample for each 1,000 cubic feet (10' x 10' x 10'). Not necessary to spray directly on insects but merely release in the air since the spray mist will disperse throughout the enclosed area. Temporarily effective in sheltered outdoor area.

#### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

**STORAGE:** Store in a cool area away from heat or open flame.

**DISPOSAL:** Do Not Puncture or Incinerate! **If empty:** Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. **If partly filled:** Call your local solid waste agency or 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions.
