FLIES, MOSQUITOS, GNATS, WASPS, FLYING ADLLT MOTHS: Determine cubic feet of space to be treated. Example: 10' high × 10' long × 10' wide = 1000 cubic feet. Close all windows and doors. Direct valve opening away from person and spray from 2 to 5 seconds for each 1000 cubic feet of space. Disperse mist in all directions and, if possible, have fans operating to speed up circulation of insecticide throughout area being treated. Leave treated area. Keep area closed for at least 15 minutes after treatment. Ventilate room completely before reoccupying. Sweep up and destroy all insects.

RICE and GRANARY WEEVILS, CONFUSED FLOUR BEETLES, RED FLOUR BEETLES, CHOCOLATE MOTHS, DRUG STORE BEETLES in exposed adult and larvae stages: Contact as many insects as possible when treating infested areas such as cracks, crevices machinery, and dark secluded areas. Spray 10 to 20 seconds per 1000 square feet of floor space. Repeat treatment weekly or as insects appear.

CARPET BEETLES: Make localized application to areas of the floor and baseboards. Spray directly into cracks and under carpe's where insects may be found. Treat crevices, cracks or closets and infested areas of shelving. Repeat as necessary.
