- 1. Delete the word CONCENTRATED which appears on the front panel of the product label, or substantiate the use of this term for a product which contains only 0.5% pyrethrins and 4.0% PBO.
- 2. Revise the sentence in the PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS section of the product label to read: In food processing facilities, all food contact surfaces, benches, shelving, utensils, etc. should be covered or removed during treatment or thoroughly washed with an effective cleaning compound followed by a potable water rinse prior to use.
- 3. For the record, submit a current Confidential Statement of Formula (EPA Form 8570-4).
