Dear Mr. Washburn:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments below:

- 1. In the FIRST AID box
 - a) Revise "IF SWALLOWED to read:

IF SWALLOWED: Immediately call a poison control center or doctor. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give any liquid to the person.

However, if you have data to show there is benefit in drinking water or milk after ingesting your product, you may submit an alternate wording via amendment.

- b) Add the statement "NOTE TO PHYSICIAN": Contains petroleum distillatevomiting my cause aspiration pneumonia."
- 2. Under the DIRECTIONS FOR USE for carpet beetles, correct the spelling of "shelving" in the third sentence.
- In the STORAGE AND DISPOSAL box, include the statement "Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal."

You must submit two (2) final printed labels before you release the product for shipment. A stamped copy is enclosed for your records.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through the skin. Avoid breathing vapors. Avoid contact with eyes, skin, or clothing.

In food processing facilities, all food contact surfaces, benches, shelving, utensils, etc. should be covered or removed during treatment or thoroughly washed with an effective cleaning compound followed by a potable water rinse prior to use.

In hospitals, patients should be romoved from the room prior to treatment. Room should be ventilated for 2 hours after spraying. Do not return patients to room until after ventilation.

PHYSICAL HAZARDS

Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat, sparks, or flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130° F. may cause bursting.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats, Wasps, Flying Adult Moths: Determine cubic feet of space to be treated. Example 10' high x 10' long x 10' wide= 1,000 cubic feet. Close all windows and doors. Direct valve opening away from person and spray from 2 to 5 seconds for each 1,000 cubic feet of space. Disperse mist in all directions and, if possible, have fans operating to speed up circulation of insecticide throughout area being treated. Leave treated area. Keep area closed for



at least 15 minutes after treatment. Ventilate room completely before reoccupying. Sweep up and destroy all insects.

Rice, and Granary Weevils, Confused Flourmoths, Red Flour Beetles, Chocolate Moths, Drug Store Beetles in exposed adult and larvae stages: Contact as many insects as possible when treating infested areas such as cracks, crevices, machinery, and dark secluded areas. Spray 10 to 20 seconds per 1,000 square feet of floor space. Repeat treatment weekly or as insects appear.

Carpet Beetles: Make localized application to areas of the floor and baseboards. Spray directly into cracks and under carpets where insects may be found. Treat devices, cracks, or closets and infested areas of sheoving. Repeat as necessary.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry area away heat or open flame.

DISPOSAL: Do Not Puncture or Incinerate! If empty: Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. If partly filled: Call your local solid waste agency or 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions.
