The proposed amendment to the registration of the product cited above under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act removing the Methvlene Chloride from the product and substituting another inert is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

1. The Petroleum Distillate should be declared as an inert ingredient. The total percentage of inert ingredients must be adjusted accordingly.
2. Since your data matrix does not give a dielectrical breakdown voltage, you must add the following statement to the use directions:

Do not use this product in or on electrical equipment due to the possibility of shock hazard.
