To apply to face, spray into palm of hand in short bursts and spread on exposed skin.

2. Although inclusion is preferred, it has been determined that it is acceptable to remove the statement "If you go to a doctor, take this repellent with you" from the product label. You may remove this statement from the label without submitting an amendment form.
