SKIN APPLICATION BITING FLIES, C

Hold unit 4 to 6 inches while applying with a spray nozzle. Surface is slightly moist to insure even distribution. Spray with palm of hand on the skin. Apply with mouth. DO NOT SPRAY

CLOTHING TREATMENT INSECTS, CHIGGER

Usually 3 to 4 ounces per application. Avoid breathing spray mist. Avoid contact with eyes, lips, or open cuts. Attention to those parts of clothing through which insects pass: tops and fly, trouser waistband, and the front
