DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Not for use on horses intended for slaughter.

FOR FACE FLIES

Remove mucous secretions and saliva deposits from face of animal. Hold dispenser 18 to 24 inches from animal. Spray face being sure to avoid eyes and mouth, and spray other body regions where flies gather for 3-4 seconds per animal. Repeat daily, or as needed.

FOR HORSE FLIES, HORN FLIES, STABLE FLIES, DEER FLIES, HOUSEFLIES, MOSQUITOS, AND GNATS

Hold container 18-24 inches from animal. Apply lightly to coat with a sweeping motion. Apply to back, belly, ear, or leg regions where the specific attacking insect feeds. Do not spray entire animal. Spray young animals sparingly.

Do not apply to back of horses prior to saddling. Repeat daily, or as needed, for protection.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. STORAGE: Store in a cool area away from heat or open flame. DISFOGAL: Do Not Puncture or Incinerate! If empty: Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. If partly filled: Call your local solid waste agency or 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions.
