Directions for Use

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Spray outdoor areas of the yard and patio when there is no breeze or spraying the direction of a slight breeze. Controts tiles, mosquitoes and gnats up to 12 feet away, using this fog nozzle.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING

Point spray nozzle away from the face and in the direction of the space to be treated. Press down valve button and allow spray fog to fill the air where flying pests linger. For larger areas, best results are obtained by spraying in the direction of a slight breeze that allows the fog to drift into the areas of infestation. Spray while moving away from treated areas. Allow spray to dissipate before occupying the treated area. Repeat as necessary.

FLYING INSECTS - Reduce annoyance from flies, mosquitoes, moths and gnats by directing spray from a distance of 4 to 6 feet from flowering plants, shrubbery and grass to where the insects may be resting. Avoid heavy wetting of plant foliage. Also spray around garbage cans and other breeding areas. Repeat as necessary.

Spray directly on wasps and hornets. Thoroughly wet the nesting area during the evening when these insects are least active.

CRAWLING INSECTS - Spray directly on ants, centipedes, sowbugs, and spiders. Treat around garbage cans, and other areas infested by these pests. Also thoroughly spray ant hills for best results. Spray in short bursts of 2 seconds a. distance of 4 to 6 feet for control of Brown Recluse Spider and Black Widow Spider. Repeat application a necessary.

Storage and Disposal

Dot not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Storage: Store in a cool area away from heat or open flame.

Disposat: Replace cap and discard in trash. Do not puncture or incinerate.


