The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Submit one (1) copy of the finished labeling prior to releasing the product for shipment.

- 1. Revise the heading ANIMAL PESTS: DOGS, CATS- Fleas: so that it does not imply that dogs and cats are considered pests. As written, this text may be confusing to the user.
- 2. Add the following statement to the paragraph which begins "Apply directly to animals along....":

Do not apply to nursing puppies and kittens, or to puppies and kittens less than 6 weeks old.

The label claim "With .25% SBP-1382" does not precisely match the declaration on the Confidential Statement of Formula. This product contains 0.25% Resmethrin and 1.67% SBP-1382, but not 0.25% SBP-1382.
