

The following amendment, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable subject to the conditions listed below.

- Update First Aid Statements
- Update Disposal Statements

Conditions

- 1. As stated previously, the use of the term "restrooms" is too broad as you have not included directions which would be appropriate for all restroom surfaces. You have not included directions for use on toilet bowls. Delete the site "restrooms" and the surface "toilet bowls" from the right panel on the first page of you label.
- 2. Delete the term "etc." and the parenthesis surrounding "locker rooms, corridors, classrooms" as well as the parenthesis following "steel, chrome, glass, vinyl" and the "etc." Your label must be specific and the language in parenthesis is not optional.

- 3. Revise the label to include the following statement in each section (Household, Hospitals, Salon, and Deodorizer) of the label. "Remove gross filth and heavy soil deposits from surfaces then apply as follows." The similar statement on the first page of the label beginning: "Note: Before using Magic Guard, first remove gross filth..." may be deleted from the label.
- 4. Revise the phrase "Application/Timing" as it appears on the first and second pages to read "Contact Time" such that your label will be consistent with other labels in the market place.
- 5. Revise each set of directions (Household, Hospitals, Food Processing Equipment, Dairies, Restaurant, Salon, and Deodorizer) to state: "Prepare fresh solution daily or more often if solution becomes diluted or soiled."
- 6. Add the following statement to the directions for use in hospitals: "At this level this product is effective against *Pseudomonas aeruginosa*."
- 7. Revise the directions for "Food processing equipment" by deleting the statement beginning: "Thoroughly clean and rinse all equipment before applying Magic Guard sanitizing solution, then immerse or wet thoroughly all food processing equipment and food utensils." and replacing with the following as per DIS/TSS-17 as previously requested: "Remove gross food particles and soil by a preflush, or pre-scrape and when necessary, pre-soak. Wash thoroughly with a good detergent or compatible cleaner, followed by a potable water rinse. Dilute Magic Guard according to the chart below. Immerse or wet thoroughly all food processing equipment and food utensils with solution. Allow product to contact surface for 1 minute, then drain and air dry."
- 8. Revise the directions for "Dairies" by deleting the statement beginning: "To sanitize dairy equipment, first clean and rinse equipment..." and ending "...with the sanitizing solution." and replacing with the following as per DIS/TSS-17 as previously requested: "Remove gross food particles and soil by a preflush, or pre-scrape and when necessary, pre-soak. Wash thoroughly with a good detergent or compatible cleaner, followed by a potable water rinse. Dilute Magic Guard according to the chart below. Immerse or wet thoroughly all dairy equipment with solution. Allow product to contact surface for 1 minute, then drain and air dry."
- 9. Revise the directions for "Restaurant and Bar Rinse" by deleting the statement beginning: "Dishes, glassware..." and ending "...rinse thoroughly and immerse." and replacing with the following as per DIS/TSS-17 as previously requested: "Sanitize dishes, glassware, silverware, and cooking utensils with this product. Remove gross food particles and soil by a preflush, or pre-scrape and when necessary, pre-soak. Wash thoroughly with a good detergent or compatible cleaner, followed by a potable water rinse. Dilute Magic Guard according to the chart below. Immerse food utensils in this solution. Allow product to contact surface for 1 minute.

- 12. Revise your "Storage and Disposal" statements, for commercial and industrial use, to include the following headings: *Pesticide* Storage and *Pesticide* Disposal. In addition, revise the Pesticide Storage statement to read: "Store in original container and keep in locked storage."
