— DIRECTIONS —

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING. ALWAYS HOLD CAN UPRIGHT WHILE SPRAYING.

TO KILL FLEAS, LICE, TICKS AND GNATS ON DOGS: Spray the animal from a distance of 8 to 12 inches. Start spraying at the tail, moving dispenser rapidly and making sure that the animal's entire body is covered, including the legs and under the body. As you spray, fluff the hair so that the spray will penetrate to the skin. Make sure spray wets ticks thoroughly. Do not spray into eyes, face or scrotum. Do not use more often than once every 7 days.

Note: Avoid treatment of nursing puppies. Over treatment may cause toxic symptoms.

Do not use on pregnant dogs.

CAUTION:

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.

Harmful if swallowed, inhaled, or absorbed through skin. Avoid contact with skin. Avoid breathing mist, application to skin, or spraying on feed or foodstuffs. Avoid storage near food or feedstuffs. Wash thoroughly after using.

Do not spray in animal's eyes. Do not spray on birds, or on nursing puppies or around fish bowls.

WARNING: Contents under pressure. Do not puncture. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting. Never throw container into fire or incinerator.
