
Since the product contains petroleum distillates, the First Aid statement for If Swallowed must be changed to read:

"If Swallowed: Immediately call a poison control center or doctor. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give **any** liquid to the person. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person."

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records. Submit two copies of the final label before this product is released for shipment under this revised label.

## ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARD

This pesticide is highly toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to water. Drift and runoff from treated sites may be hazardous to fish in adjacent waters.

## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

To control flies and mosquitoes, close room and spray into air. Adjust the nozzle of the sprayer to give the finest mist possible. Spray at a rate of ¼ to 1 fluid ounce per 1,000 cubic feet or until a moderate mist can be seen in all parts of the room. It is not necessary to spray the air heavily. Keep

the room closed for 10 minutes. Do not remain in treated areas. Ventilate the room after treatment is completed. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects.

Remove pets, birds, and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

#### **STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

**STORAGE:** Store in a cool, dry area away heat or open flame.

**DISPOSAL:** If empty: Do not reuse this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. If partly filled: Call your local solid waste agency or 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.
