

- The ventriation system shall be stopped and all openings to the exterior kept closed while the insecticide is being released or sprayed, and for a period of not less than three minutes thereafter. If disinsectization is accomplished on the ground prior to take-off, the ventilation system may be opened at the end of such period, provided that the system is equipped with filters or other means for preventing the entrance of insects into the aircraft, but doors, windows, or other such openings to the exterior shall be kept closed until after the take-off, except in the case of emergency, or to permit persons applying the insecticide to debark.
- II. The insecticide shall be dispensed (1.8 gm/sec) in the amount of not less than 5 grams for each 1,000 cubic feet of enclosed space in the aircraft, and shall be released or sprayed throughout all accessible compartments.
- III. Disinsecting may be accomplished either while the aircraft is on the ground before take-off from the last airport before arrival in the United States, or after departure from such airport (for compartments accessible in flight.) In no case shall disinsecting be accomplished later than 30 minutes before the first landing at a United States port.
