APPLY IN SHORT BURSTS.

To Kill Flies, Mosquitoes, Small Flying Moths and Gnats: Close all doors and windows and direct spray upward into center of room with a slow sweeping motion. Spray 5-10 seconds for average room. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate room thoroughly before re-entry. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects.

To Kill Cockroaches, Ants and Crickets: Contact as many insects as possible with the spray in addition to thorough spraying of all parts of the room suspected of harboring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, hidden surfaces, under sinks, behind stoves, and refrigerator, food storage areas and wherever these pests are suspected of hiding. To kill ants, treat doors and window frames, ant trails and other areas of entry. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Carpet Beetles: Directly spray as many insects as possible. Spray both interior and exterior of upholstered furniture. Bed and pillow trimmings and carpets should be sprayed thoroughly. Also treat shelves, closets, areas under furniture and wherever these insects are suspected. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Exposed Forms of Confused Flour Beetles, Saw-toothed Grain Beetles, and Rice Weevils: Find and destroy infested package goods. Remove all other items from pantry. Spray the shelves to kill any of the named insects present. Place clean paper on the shelves and return packages after shelves have dried. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Sowbugs, Centipedes, Firebrats and Spiders: Contact as many insects as possible with the spray. Also thoroughly spray cracks, crevices and suspected harborage. Wash up and clean up after treatment. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Fleas and Brown Dog Ticks: Remove all dogs and cats from room. Spray sleeping quarters of pets around and under them. Wash and dry bedding with detergent and hot water. Repeat as necessary. Do not spray humans. Remove clothing from quarters after spraying. Wash and dry clothing with detergent and hot water. Repeat as necessary.
