

Precautionary Statements
Hazardous to Humans and Domestic Animals

CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed. Avoid inhalation of vapors. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Wash contaminated skin promptly with soap and warm water. For eyes, flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists. Avoid contamination of food and feed stuffs.

Do not use in commercial food processing, preparation, serving or storage areas. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Cover exposed food.

Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

Physical Hazards

Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperature above 130°F may cause bursting.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF INHALED- Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

IF ON SKIN- Remove contaminated clothing. Wash skin with soap and warm water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

IF IN EYES- Flush eyes with plenty of water. Obtain medical attention if irritation persists.

IF SWALLOWED- Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Do not induce vomiting without medical supervision because of possible aspiration hazard.

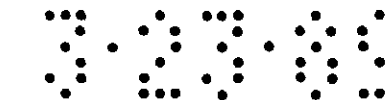

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Use one canister for each 6,000 cu. ft. of unobstructed area. (Example: 30' long x 20' wide x 10' high = 6,000 cu. ft.) Use additional units for remote rooms or where less than stated treat is not assured.

PREPARATION: Cover exposed food. Remove hanging equipment. Open cupboards and drawers to be treated. Shut off fans and air conditioners. Put out all open flames except pilot light. Remove pets and cover fish tanks or fish bowls with paper, or remove from area. Close exterior doors and windows.

TO START FOGGING: Place Fogger on table, chair or stand, at least six feet from pilot light. Place several thicknesses of newspapers under canister to prevent shoving of surface. Hold can at arm's length, with top of can pointing away from face and eyes. Push down on finger pad until it clicks - this will start fogging action. Set canister in upright position on table, etc. and leave fogging at once. DO NOT RE-ENTER BUILDING FOR FOUR HOURS. Then open exterior doors and windows and allow to air for 30 minutes before reoccupying area.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in a cool, dry area away from heat or open flame.

Disposal: Replace cap. Wrap container and put in trash collection. Do not puncture or incinerate container.
