DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Use one canister for each 6,000 cu. ft. of unobstructed area. Example 30' long x 20' wide x 10' high = 6,000 cu. ft. DO NOT use more than one fogger per room. Use additional units for remote rooms or where free flow of mist is not assured.

DO NOT use in small, enclosed spaces such as closets, cabinets or under counters or tables. Do not use in a room 5 ft x 5 ft. or smaller, instead, allow fog to enter from other rooms. Turn of ALL ignition sources such as pilot lights (shut off gas valves), other open flames or running electrical applicances that cycle off and on (i.e., refrigerators, thermostats, etc) Call your gas utility or management company if you need assistance with your pilot lights.

PREPARATION: Cover exposed food, dishes, and food handling equipment. Open cabinets and doors to areas to be treated. Shut off fans and air conditioners. Put out all open flames except pilot light. Remove pets and cover fish tanks or fish bowls with paper, or remove from area. Close exterior doors and windows.

TO START FOGGING: Place fogger on table, chair or stand, at least six feet from pilot light. Place several thicknesses of newspapers under

canister to prevent marring of surface. Hold can at arm's length with top of can pointing away from face and eyes. Push down on finger pad until it locks—this will start fogging action. Set canister in upright position on table, etc. and leave building at once.

DO NOT RE-ENTER BUILDING FOR FOUR HOURS, then open exterior doors and windows and allow to air for 30 minutes before reoccupying area.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry area away from heat or open flame.
