DIRECTIONS FOR USE ON AIRCRAFT

To Kill Mosquitoes, Gnats, Houseflies and Caribbean Fruit Flies: Use while aircraft is in
flight. Turn on sprayer and direct use at least 30 minutes prior to landing. Stop ventila-
tion system in cabin for at least 3 minutes after spraying. Spray 10 grams (10
sprays) per 100 cubic feet. Push button to spray. Move arm from side to side in a
width of 10 to 15 degrees.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE IN BUILDINGS, VANS, SHIPS AND IN TENTAGE

FOR INDOOR USE ONLY

For use By Department of Defense Personnel Only

To Kill Flying Insects, Mosquitoes, Houseflies and Gnats: Close space to be treated.
Hold sprayer 3 feet from any surface. Holding sprayer above the head. Moving the
sprayer in a slow circular motion. Discontinue spraying when indicated. Ten seconds of
spraying should treat 100 to 200 cubic feet. To treat 100 cubic feet, keep treated area
closed at least 30 minutes, ventilate area before re-entry. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Cockroaches: Contact as many insects as possible with the spray, in addition to
the crevices and parts of the room suspected of harboring cockroaches. Repeat
spraying until the cockroaches are dead on surfaces and where these pests are
most likely to hide.
