Dear Mr. Washburn:

The labeling amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments below:

- Delete the term "Professional Strength" from your product name in accordance with a PR Notices 91-07 and 93-06. A notification in accordance to PR Notice 98-10 must be submitted to reflect the new primary product name.
- 2. Under Precautionary Statements, delete the sentence that reads "All food processing surfaces should be covered during treatment or thoroughly cleaned before using." and replace it with "All food processing surfaces and equipment should be washed with an effective cleaning compound followed by a potable water rinse."
- 3. Under DIRECTIONS FOR USE:
 - a. You may delete "GENERAL CLASSIFICATION" because it is no longer required to be on the label.
 - b. Under "To kill cockroaches . . . , correct the spelling of "wherever" in the second sentence.
 - c. Correct the spelling of "Too Kill Flies" to "To Kill Flies".
- 4. In the STORAGE AND DISPOSAL box, include the statement "Do not contaminate

water, food, or feed by storage or disposal."

You must submit two (2) final printed label before you release the product for shipment. A stamped copy is enclosed for your records.

To Kill Exposed Forms of Confused Flour Beetles, Saw-Toothed Grain Beetles, and Rice Weevils: Find and destroy infested package goods. Remove all other items from pantry. Spray the shelves to kill any of the named insects present. Place clean paper on the shelves and return

packages after shelves have dried. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Sowbugs, Centipedes, Firebrats and Spiders: Contact as many insects as possible with the spray. Also thoroughly spray all parts of the room suspected of harboring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, crevices, hidden surfaces under sinks and behind stoves and refrigerators.

To Kill Fleas and Brown Dog Ticks: Remove and destroy old pet bedding. Spray sleeping quarters of pets, around faseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks and local areas of floors. Repeat as necessary. Do not spray animals. Put fresh bedding in pets quarters after spray has dried. Also treat dogs and cats with a registered flea and tick control product before allowing them to enter treated area.
