

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals
CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed. Avoid inhalation of vapors. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. Wash contaminated skin promptly with soap and warm water. Flush contaminated eyes with plenty of water and get medical attention. If swallowed, do not induce vomiting. Call a physician immediately.

Keep away from food and feedstuff. DO NOT use in edible products areas of food processing plants, restaurants or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in food serving areas while food is exposed. Do not allow children or pets to contact treated surfaces until spray has dried. Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying. This product is toxic to fish. Do not contaminate water.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Contains petroleum distillate. If gastric lavage is deemed necessary, undertake only after proper placement of a cuffed endotracheal tube. Active ingredients contain a cholinesterase inhibitor. Treat symptomatically. Atropine is an antidote.

This product may stain certain surfaces; test beforehand to determine whether safe against staining. Some asphalt tile, linoleum and plastic materials are harmed by petroleum based insecticides. Pre-test before applying.

PHYSICAL HAZARDS

FLAMMABLE, contents under pressure. Do not use near fire, heated surfaces, sparks or flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F. may cause bursting.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.
STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry area away from heat or flame.
DISPOSAL: Replace cap and discard container in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING: Remove contaminated clothing. Wash skin with soap and warm water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

IF IN EYES: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Do not induce vomiting because of aspiration hazard.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

HOLD CAN AS UPRIGHT AS POSSIBLE. Press valve, directing the spray to infested areas. Be sure to coat (spray) crevices and cracks for residual. Repeat applications as necessary for control.

ROACHES, ANTS, CRICKETS, SILVER-FISH, SPIDERS: Spray areas where these pests are found or may hide, including dark corners of rooms and closets, cracks and crevices of walls, along baseboards and door and window frames, behind and beneath sinks, stoves, refrigerators and cabinets and around garbage cans, plumbing and other utility installations. Pests driven out of hiding places should be sprayed directly. For ants apply to ant trails, also around doors and windows and wherever else these pests may find entrance.

BROWN DOG TICKS: To control these pests, thoroughly apply as a spot treatment to infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, window and door frames and localized areas of floor and floor covering where these pests may be present. Old bedding of pets should be removed and replaced with clean, fresh bedding after treatment. Do not spray pets with this product.

FLIES AND MOSQUITOES: Use only out-of-doors as an aid in reducing annoyance from these insects. Spray outside surfaces of window and door frames as well as other areas where these pests may enter the home. Also spray dark corners and localized resting areas (such as under eaves) or porches, patios, and garages where these insects may congregate. Flies and mosquitoes coming to rest on treated surfaces will be killed. Repeat treatment when effectiveness diminishes.
