1. The submitted label does not include a Storage And Disposal statement. Reinstate this statement as it appears on the label accepted March 20, 1991.

2. Also reinstate the footnotes to the ingredient statement concerning isomers as they appear on the label accepted March 20, 1991.

The Confidential Statement of Formula is acceptable and has been added to the file.

We understand that you will be submitting the required product chemistry data.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS CAUTION

This product will kill Houseflies, Mosquitoes, Ticks, Black Carpet Beetles, Saw-toothed Grain Beetles, Rice Weevils, Small Flying Moths, Centipedes, Wasps, Pill Bugs, Crickets, Silverfish, and Cockroaches.

To control fleas and ticks, remove them and replace. Repeat as necessary. One can treats one 6,000 cubic feet (20'x 30'x 10') area. Results are not assured.

PREPARATION: Cover food handling equipment, etc. to area to be treated. Shut off all flames. Put out all flames. Use fogger not less than 10 feet from doors and windows. Point nozzle away from face and eyes when releasing fog. Leave area during treatment and before re-entry.

TO START FOGGING: Pull out stand, at least six feet from wall. Push down on finger pad to prevent marring of surface. Push down on finger pad to start fogging action. Set canister on table, etc. and leave treated area. **RE-ENTER TREATED AREA:** then open exterior doors and windows for 30 minutes before re-entry.
