Dear Mr. Washburn:

Your label amendment application dated March 6, 2003 and approved on July 2, 2003 supercedes this label amendment application. However, we have identified a few additional deficiencies. Therefore, at the next printing of your labeling, please amend the label as follows:

1. In the FIRST AID box:
 - a. Under "IF SWALLOWED, delete the second bullet and replace with "Do not give any liquid to the person." However, if you have data to show there is benefit in drinking water or milk after ingesting your product, you may submit an alternate wording via amendment.
 - b. Add the statement "NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Contains petroleum distillate - vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia."
2. In the STORAGE AND DISPOSAL box, include the statement "Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal."

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

This product will kill Houseflies, Mosquitoes, Fleas, Ticks, Black Carpet Beetles, Saw-toothed Grain Beetles, Rice Weevils, Small Flying Moths, Spiders, Centipedes, Wasps, Pill Bugs, Crickets, Silverfish and Cockroaches.

To control fleas and ticks, destroy old bedding and replace. Repeat as necessary. Treat dogs and cats with a registered tick control product prior to re-entry. One can treats one obstructed area up to 6,000 cu. ft. (20' x 30' x 10' ceiling). Use additional units for remote rooms or where free flow of mist is not assured.

PREPARATION: Cover exposed food, dishes, and food handling equipment. Open cabinets and doors to areas to be treated. Shut off fans and air conditioners. Put out all open flames except pilot light. Position fogger not less than 6 ft. from pilot light. Close doors and windows. Point valve opening away from face and eyes when releasing. Do not remain in the area during treatment and ventilate thoroughly before re-entry.

TO START FOGGING: Place fogger on table, chair or stand, at least six feet from pilot light. Place several thicknesses of newspapers under canister to prevent marring of surface. Hold can at arm's length with top of can pointing away

from face and eyes. Push down on finger pad until it locks. This will start fogging action. Set canister in upright position on table, etc. and leave building at once.

DO NOT RE-ENTER TREATED AREA FOR FOUR HOURS, then open exterior doors and windows and allow to air for 30 minutes before reoccupying area.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry area away from heat or open flame.
