Your label amendment application dated March 6, 2003 and approved on July 2, 2003 supercedes this label amendment application. However, we have identified a few additional deficiencies. Therefore, at the next printing of your labeling, please amend the label as follows:

- 1. In the FIRST AID box:
 - a. Under "IF SWALLOWED, delete the second bullet and replace with "Do not give any liquid to the person." However, if you have data to show there is benefit in drinking water or milk after ingesting your product, you may submit an alternate wording via amendment.
 - b. Add the statement "NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Contains petroleum distillate vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia."
- 2. In the STORAGE AND DISPOSAL box, include the statement "Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal."

To control fleas and ticks, destroy old bedding and replace. Repeat as necessary. Treat dogs and cats with a registered tick control product prior to reentry. One can treats one obstructed area up to 6,000 cu. ft. (20' x 30' x 10' ceiling). Use additional units for remote rooms or where free flow of mist is not assured.
