To kill carpet beetles: Directly spray as many insects as possible. Spray both interior and exterior of upholstered furniture. Both top and bottom of rugs and carpets should be sprayed thoroughly. Also treat shelves, closets, areas under furniture and wherever these insects are seen or suspected. Repeat as necessary.

To kill exposed forms of confused flour beetles, saw-toothed grain beetles, and rice weevils: Find and destroy infested packaged goods. Remove all other items from pantry. Spray shelves to kill any of the named insects present. Place clean paper on the shelves and return packages after shelves have dried. Repeat as necessary.

To kill sowbugs, centipedes, firebrats and spiders: Contact as many insects as possible with the spray. Also thoroughly spray all parts of the room suspected of harboring these pests.
