DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Use one canister for each 6,000 cu. ft. of unobstructed area. Example: 30' long X 20' wide X 10' high = 6,000 cu. ft. Use additional units for remote rooms or where the free flow of the mist is not assured.

PREPARATION: Open cabinets and doors to areas to be treated. Shut off fans and air conditioners. Put out all open flames except pilot light. Remove pets and cover fish tanks or fish bowls with paper, or remove from area. Close exterior doors and windows. Cover exposed foods, dishes, and food handling equipment.
