Speer 2x Indoor Fogger (Double strength)
EPA Registration No. 11715-81
Submission: September 20, 1988

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with Registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable. A stamped copy is enclosed for your records.

The revised formula, dated September 20, 1988 is acceptable and has been included in our files for this pesticide. It is understood that use of methylene chloride in this formulation would no longer be consistent with the terms of its registration.

As new labels are printed,
a. Delete petroleum distillate as an active ingredient; include its total in the inert percentage; and add a substatement to the ingredient statement - "Contains petroleum distillate".

b. Delete - "GENERAL" Classification - uses of this pesticide have not been classified.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If swallowed- Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. If vomiting is indicated if no vomit was taken internally, INDUCE VOMITING. Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia.

If inhaled- Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

If on skin- Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.

If in eyes- Flush eyes with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed. Avoid inhalation of vapors. Avoid contact with eyes, or clothing. Wash contaminated skin promptly with soap and water. For eyes, flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists. Avoid contamination of food and feedstuffs. Do not use in food processing, preparation, serving, or storage areas. GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry area away from heat or open flame.

DISPOSAL: Replace cap and discard containers in trash. Do not puncture or incinerate.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Use one canister for each 6,000 cu. ft. of unobstructed area. Example: 30' long X 20' wide X 10' high = 6,000 cu. ft. Use additional units for remote rooms or where the free flow of the mist is not assured.

PREPARATION: Open cabinets and doors to areas to be treated. Shut off fans and air conditioners. Put out all open flames except pilot light. Remove pets and cover fish tanks or fish bowls with paper or remove from area. Close exterior doors and windows. Cover exposed foods, dishes and food handling equipment.

TO START FOGGING: Place Fogger on table, chair or stand at least six feet from back light. Place several thicknesses of newspapers under canister to prevent marring of surface. Hold can at arm's length, with top of can pointing away from face and eyes. Push down on finger pad until it locks—this will start fogging action. Set canister in upright position on table, etc. and leave building at once. DO NOT RE-ENTER BUILDING FOR FOUR HOURS. Then open exterior doors and windows and allow to air for 30 minutes before reoccupying area.
